# Building Hope through Servant Leadership

Each session is a mixture of input, discussion, group work etc. as we explore together what Servant Leadership is and why we should be engaged in it. The 5 evenings will help people to reflect on how this relates to our Baptism, the dynamics of Group work, praying together, mission and outreach (especially around care of our common home) and a renewed understanding of coresponsibility. The growth and practice of Servant Leadership is an important key to the success of our diocesan Building Hope initiative.
