REFLECTION

It's funny how we readily accept that Lent is a season but think of Easter as a day. Perhaps if we have given up something we really enjoy, the forty days of Lent seem interminable, whereas eaten cake (or in this case, Easter eggs!) is quickly forgotten. Or is it that Catholics, and particularly Irish Catholics, are more at home with suffering than with joy?

We forget that Easter is an even longer season than Lent, as we journey the fifty days through Ascension to Pentecost. The focus of the scripture readings throughout the Easter season is on the dynamic beginnings of the early Church, as described in Luke's second book, the Acts of the Apostles. The presence of the risen Christ guiding the nascent Church through the action of the Holy Spirit nearly jumps off each page. But far more important is the call to recognise the action of the Spirit of the risen Christ in our lives, in our own daily experience of falling and rising again. This is particularly true with regard to sin and forgiveness, or of the experience of loss and the courage to begin again.

As we pray that the Spirit will come in a special way upon the boys and girls expecting to receive Confirmation in the next week or two, may we be ready to recognise and respond to the Spirit's action and promptings in our own lives. Christ is risen!
