# **2025 Weekly Envelope Boxes**

The new Family Offering Parish Envelopes boxes will be available to be collected at the back of the Church after all Masses on the weekend of  $22^{nd}/23^{rd}$  of February. Your support for the Family Offering is greatly appreciated. The Parish depends on the voluntary contributions of parishioners for the running and development of the Parish

The new envelope boxes for the Sunday collections at Mass will also be available for collection. If you don't already use these envelopes for your Sunday Mass donations, please consider doing so. By donating to the Mass collections using these envelopes rather than directly into the baskets **your donation could be worth up to 45% more to the church, at no extra cost to you!** 

For example, if you pay income tax and your total annual donation (to the Family Offering, First and Second collections and Dues) is €250 or more per year, we can claim a refund from Revenue on the tax that you have already paid. This refund is available through the **CHY Charitable Donation Scheme** for approved charities. Last year the Parish received a CHY income tax refund of €44,960, which was of immense help to the parish finances

## The Council of Nicaea, the Bible and the Church Fathers

2025 marks the 1,700<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Council of Nicaea in AD 325. Nicaea clarified church teaching on the Trinity and the Incarnation, that God is three and yet one and that Christ is fully God and fully man. The Council of Nicaea gave us language that we repeat every Sunday - that Jesus is "consubstantial" with the Father, true God from true God, l begotten not made.
