

Blessing and Opening of St. Cronan's Pastoral Centre Format of the Day

Earlier this month we held an open meeting to hear from people the way that we should mark this important event in our Parish. From the discussions that took place the Parish Pastoral Council took the ideas and shaped them as follows:

Mass will take place at 12:30pm on Sunday 5th June.

There will be no 11:00am Mass that Sunday.

Both Choirs and our Saturday night cantor will lead the music.

The Scouts and Order of Malta will form a colour party.

In the opening procession the name plaques for the various rooms in the Pastoral Centre will be placed in the sacred space.

The Prayer of the Faithful will be read in the various languages of the Parish.

After Mass a procession will lead Archbishop Martin to the Pastoral Centre.

He will unveil the plaque in the porch and proceed into the Centre for the Prayer of Blessing.

There will be a sound link for people in the Church to hear the ceremony.

In the Pastoral Centre there will be people gathered representing the various groups in the Parish and the various groups that use the Pastoral Centre. Among them a group of twenty who will be drawn by lottery from the buy-a-brick certificates. The Parish Pastoral Council, the Pastoral Centre Development Group and Pastoral Centre Management Committee will also be there.

After the Blessing the Archbishop will be presented with a History of the Parish.

Refreshments will be served for everybody in the Pastoral Centre and the Scouts will have their famous bar-b-que sausages in the Pastoral Centre Garden.

While some people have been received an invitation due to their role in the ceremony or their association with the Parish, the invitation that has been in the Newsletter over the past weeks is the invitation to all our Parishioners and Friends.



OUR LINKS WITH ST. MEL'S CATHEDRAL PAR

On **Sunday May 22nd** Dr John O'Keeffe will be coming to our church to hear the congregation at the 11.00 am Mass sing his recently composed Mass of St Mel for the restoration of the Cathedral of St. Mel after it was destroyed by fire.

Dr O'Keeffe's intention was to make this Mass setting fully congregationfriendly and our parish was asked to try it out in the early stages of its composition, starting with the Apostles' Creed. Dr O'Keeffe said that he would never have completed the Mass if it hadn't been for the successful execution of the pilot scheme here in Brackenstown. We would ask all regular attendees at the 11am Mass to make a special effort to be here on the 22nd so that we may lift our voices together in praise of God.

Dr O'Keefe is one of the country's finest organists and he will accompany both choir and congregation on that day.

Celebrating First Holy Communion and Confirmation

Over the next three Saturdays we will celebrate these Sacraments in our Parish. It will mean that there will be some changes to the Saturday Schedule.

On the 14th May at 10:00am Gaelscoil Bhrian Boroimhe and at 12:00noon Swords and Thornleigh ETNS.

On the 21st May St. Cronan's J.N.S. will be at 10:00am and 12:00noon.

On these days morning Mass will be at 8:45am. There will be no morning Confessions or Adoration.

On the 28th May Holywell, Swords and Thornleigh ETNS will celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation at 11:00am.

Morning Mass will be at 9:30am there will be no morning confessions or Adoration.

If you are a minister of the Eucharist and have a child or grandchild celebrating Communion or Confirmation on these days, please contact Louise in the Parish Office as we will need Ministers on these days.

Please keep the children and their families in your prayers at these important moments in their lives and in the life of the Parish.

Pathways is a two-year one night a week course for adults who wish to explore their faith. It runs from mid-September to May each year. There are no exams and no written work. The only requirement is an openness to listening to others and to participate. You can just come along and enjoy! The cost is €400 for the coming academic year and the parish will cover half of this. Booking is now open. The programme begins this year in Clonliffe College on Thursday 22nd September 2016, 7:00pm—9:30pm.
