Parish Finance Committee



At present the Parish Finance Committee is working on a number of projects. The first they are looking at is the installation of solar panels on the Church roof to help in the rising cost of electricity and to respond to Pope Francis call to all Parishes to do what they can to care for Our Common Home. The panels will be located on the flat roof near the Pastoral Centre. With the electricity they generate and store in batteries as well as the night rate which will top up the batteries, there will be significant savings and the cost of installing the panels will be made back in about five years.

Changes to our Parish

On Sunday 3rd July we will mark the ministry of Fr. Paul at the 11:00am Mass. He will conclude his ministry with us on Friday 8th July.

On Sunday 28th August we will mark the ministry of Fr. Bibin and Niamh at the 11:00am. Both will conclude their ministry that day.

Some have asked about being part of a presentation. Given the times that we are living in we are going to have one opportunity for a collection between now and the 3rd July and this will be split three ways. There are envelopes at the back of the Church.

Fr. Richard Sheehy will begin his ministry on 9th July at the 6:00pm Mass. The Priest who will come after Fr. Bibin will begin at the start of September.

For the summer there will be some changes to the timetable. From 8th July the Rosary, Night Prayer and Taizé Prayer will take break for the summer.

Fr. Richard will meet with those involved with these prayers later in the summer.
