November is a month of contrasts. With the change to wintertime the days are shorter and darker, and yet when we go for a walk along Brackenstown Road or through the Jacko, we are struck by the beautiful colours of the turning leaves, as the trees put on one last great show before winter strips them bare. Nature is going through its own retreat until, the arrival of Spring, so it is an opportune time to reflect on our own mortality and to ask ourselves if we are making the best use of our time and gifts. Are we living the life which God has dreamed for us? It is also traditionally the time when we remember our deceased loved ones, particularly those who may have died in the past year. Many parishes, and indeed many clubs and organisations will hold an annual service or Mass of Remembrance for those who died during the past year, and these all help with the grieving response. They also remind us that we remain in a communion of love and faith with our deceased loved ones in the Holy Spirit. Or, as one writer puts it, 'In prayer we stand in God's presence in the company of someone we love, even if that person has gone before us into death.' At this moment, we are particularly conscious of all those who are dying unnecessarily because of conflict in various parts of the world. It is especially distressing to hear of the deaths of so many children in the Holy Land in recent days. We can only continue to pray for an end to the violence and suffering, and for the safe delivery of aid to those who are in greatest need. Fr. Richard
