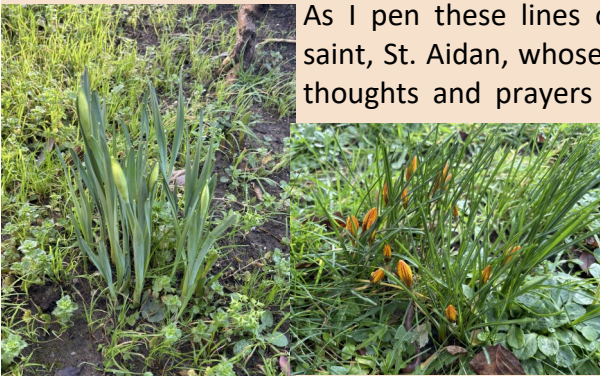

St. Brigid is fast becoming the most popular saint in Ireland, if for no other reason than her being the occasion for our having a public holiday this Monday! Joking aside, the weekend offers us an opportunity to reflect on the significance for today of St. Brigid, whose feast day falls on the 1st February. While it is sometimes difficult to separate fact from legend, Brigid the Christian from the pagan goddess, she holds a special place in our imagination and is today associated with the struggle for peace and justice, Celtic spirituality and the care of our precious planet. Afri (Action from Ireland) have for many years hosted a Feile Brid conference in the Solas Bhride centre in Kildare, which seeks to explore many of these themes. February also signals the beginning of Spring, and, as if on cue, it is great to see the crocuses and snowdrops displaying their colour and daffodil stems pushing up through the soil. As I pen these lines on the feast of another Irish saint, St. Aidan, whose beautiful cathedral at Enniscorthy was designed by Pugin, our thoughts and prayers are with the people of Enniscorthy, and other places in the south-east of the country and indeed in our own county, which have been badly flooded in recent days by excessive rainfall. We are planning a **Novena of Grace** this year around the Feast of St. Francis Xavier, which will run from Friday 6th March through to Sunday 15th March. As well as the regular Mass at 10.00am, there will be an extra weekday Mass at 7.30pm, at which a guest speaker will lead a reflection. A full programme will be published next weekend.
