

This weekend, St Mary's Pro-Cathedral celebrates its bicentenary. Archbishop Dermot Farrell will lead a special celebration of Mass at the Pro-Cathedral this Friday 14th November, feast of St. Laurence O' Toole, patron of our diocese. We also mark this year the 800th anniversary of the canonisation of St Laurence, who was Archbishop of Dublin at the time of the Norman invasion and who died in the town of Eu in Normandy in 1180. Among those taking part in the Mass on Friday will be a small delegation from the town of Eu, whose church is dedicated to St. Laurence. Archbishop Dermot Farrell led a similar delegation from the diocese on pilgrimage to Eu earlier this year. St. Mary's Pro-Cathedral was dedicated on 14th November 1825. It is the cathedral church of the Catholic Archbishop of Dublin, and it is where priests and lay representatives from every parish in the diocese gather with the Archbishop each year on Holy Thursday for the celebration of the Mass of Chrism. It is also the home of the Palestrina (boys) choir and St. Mary's Pro-Cathedral Girls' Choir. RTE's Nationwide featured a programme earlier this week on the history of the Pro-Cathedral, and as has been publicised, Archbishop Dermot Farrell has applied to Rome for St. Mary's to be granted full cathedral status. Apart from the Mass on Friday, a Hope Concert will take place on Saturday 15th November at 7.00pm.
