






Please note articles to be submitted for the Newsletter need to be emailed / left in to the Parish Office no later than 12 noon on the Tuesday before the weekend of publishing.

World Mission Sunday takes place on the second last Sunday of October each year. Since 1926, the Church has traditionally remembered its universal mission during the month of October. This year Mission Sunday will be celebrated globally on the 23rd October 2016. The theme is 'Every Christian is a missionary'.

On Mission Sunday, in a special way, we celebrate the work of circa 1,300 Irish born missionaries and all missionaries throughout the world. We thank God for them, for all who support them in our own country and during mission month we



unite ourselves in prayer with them and with the communities with whom they work.
