### Reflection

Traditionally known as Good Shepherd Sunday, the Fourth Sunday of Easter places before us the image of Jesus as the Good Shepherd. In a week where we are celebrating the Sacrament of Confirmation in our church, it is a timely reminder of the call for all Christians, rooted in our baptism, not just to follow Christ (as sheep follow a shepherd) but to be good shepherds ourselves. This Sunday is also traditionally a Day of Prayer for Vocations to the priesthood, diaconate and religious life, but in our Synodal Church today, it is just as important that we emphasise the vocation of the lay faithful. Many parishioners respond to that call by coming forward to serve as members of the Pastoral Council, ministers of the Word or of the Eucharist, members of the St. Vincent de Paul or other parish groups.
