### PARISH FINANCE TABLE


Parish Finance Committee members & helpers will be manning our annual finance tables at the back of the Church at all Masses next weekend, 11th & 12th November.

(1) **The Family Offering is the main source of income** to meet the running costs of the Parish. It pays for the day to day costs of running the Parish as well as maintaining the Church buildings. If you are not already contributing and would like a standing order form or box of Family Offering envelopes please leave your contact details at the Finance Table or to the Parish Office.

(2) **First Collection Envelopes;** In February we became only the second parish in Dublin to introduce an envelope system for the first collection at Mass. In January a further six parishes will follow our example and introduce such envelopes. If you have any queries regarding the new procedure please ask. Thanks to the 83 households who are already using the first collection envelopes. The scheme is only of added benefit to the Parish if you are paying tax. If you are a tax payer and make recorded contributions of €250 or more in a calendar year then the Parish can reclaim the tax on your contribution. This applies to contributions made by way of the Family Offering, Christmas & Easter Dues, First Collection envelope or any other recorded donation. The refund is by way of the CHY charity tax refund scheme.

(3) **Second Collection (Share) envelopes.** In the new year eight parishes, including Brackenstown, will be introducing envelopes for the second collection. This will enable us to include these recorded second collection envelopes in the CHY tax refund claim.




