# 4TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME 29TH JANUARY 2023 Year A

The Diocesan Building Hope Initiative enters a new phase this year, as we form a new partnership of parishes, which now embraces Donabate/Balheary as well as the existing Swords parishes of River Valley and Dublin Airport, Brackenstown and Swords/Drynam. The parish teams (clergy, parish sisters and secretaries met already this past week, and we are now preparing for a joint meeting of the four Parish Pastoral Councils in early February. This will lead to the establishing of a new Partnership Council which will involve clergy and representatives from each of the existing Pastoral Councils.

The new Partnership Council will not replace the existing Pastoral Councils but work in tandem with them, looking at various ways the parishes can work more closely together, such as training people for various parish ministries and developing faith formation programmes. We will provide more detail on this shortly, but for the moment we simply invite parishioners to We make this our prayer through Christ Our Lord. Amen. pray that the Holy Spirit will guide us as we move forward on this collaborative journey. We encourage parishioners to pray regularly the Building Hope Prayer, which is attached here.

# The Bible Timeline -**Understand the Entire Bible**

Reading the Bible should bring us closer to Christ, but understanding it is often difficult. The good news is that you can understand the Bible, and The Bible Timeline, a twenty-four part Bible study, makes it easy.

Presenter Jeff Cavins shows you how fourteen

of the Bible's narrative books tell the biblical story from beginning to end and gives you the keys to understanding the story woven throughout Scripture. The Bible Timeline divides the Bible into twelve colour-coded time periods that make it easier to follow its narrative thread. You will learn the major people, places, and events of the Bible and discover how they all come together to reveal the story of our faith. St. Cronan's Parish will offer The Bible Timeline beginning on Monday 20th February at 7.30 to 9.00 pm. Participants will meet every week to view a 50minute video presentation followed by a group discussion and an opportunity to ask questions. Many thanks to all those who have returned Christmas Offerings, which form part of the remuneration of the priests of the parish and of the diocese.


## SAFEGUARDING INFORMATION EVENINGS
