Around half a million young people from over all over the world, among them 600 from Ireland, including about 20 pilgrims from Dublin, are participating in the **Jubilee of Youth** in Rome, as one of the events marking the universal Church's Jubilee year. Between the 28th July and the 3rd of August, the Vatican and Rome will host a series of events dedicated to young

Catholics from at least 146 countries. For many of the Irish young pilgrims, it will be their first experience of meeting so many people of their own age from all over the world who share the gift of faith, which will no doubt give them great encouragement for their own faith journey when they return home . The Jubilee began with a Mass of welcome in St Peter's Square on Tuesday evening, after which Pope Leo drove through the square to meet the young people . Addressing them, he said: "You are the salt of the earth, the light of the world! And today your voices, your enthusiasm, your cries — all of them for Jesus Christ — will be heard to the ends of the earth! The world needs messages of hope. You are that message, and you must continue bringing hope to everyone. Let us walk together with our faith in Jesus Christ. And our cry must also be for peace in the world. Let us pray for peace, and let us be witnesses of the peace of Jesus Christ, of reconciliation — this light of the world that we are all seeking."

On Friday, the Circus Maximus will host a Day of Penance in which 200 stations will be made available for pilgrims to hear confessions. Saturday will be dedicated to music, with groups taking turn to entertain the crowd on a stage set up at Tor Vergata. The Jubilee of Youth will culminate in a Mass on Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup> August at Rome's Tor Vergata. Around a thousand parishes, schools and families will provide accommodation and breakfast for pilgrims in addition to a large hostel capable of hosting about 25,000 people set up at the Fiera di Roma. The Youth Jubilee will incorporate World Youth Day this year, as announced in 2023 by the late Pope Francis.

#### SPRING SYNOD GATHERINGS:

In March 2025, synod gatherings took place across the 5 pastoral areas of the Archdiocese, along with a 6th youth synod gathering. Clergy, chairs of Pastoral Councils, Paris Synod Animators, and pastoral staff were invited, with around 300 people from the Diocese present at the gatherings. The National Synod Team provided 17 topics for discussion that had emerged from the first synod gatherings in 2022. The aim of the spring gatherings was to prioritise the topics that should be a focus from the Pre-National Synod gatherings, beginning in October 2025. The 'Conversations in the Spirit' method was used to discern on 3 aspects: What the 3 priorities are out of the list of 17 topics? And what are the priorities that the Holy Spirit is prompting us to recommend to the Pre-Synodal Assembly in October 2025?
