ANNUAL CROSSCARE COLLECTION 2016

The Annual Collection for *Crosscare*, our Diocesan Social Care and Support Agency, takes the place of the Share Collection at all Masses today.

This year *Crosscare* celebrates its 75th Anniversary. Founded in 1941 to address poverty in wartime Dublin, *Crosscare* continues today to put faith into action through bringing Christian love to the

today to put faith into action through bringing Christian love to those who are vulnerable, most in need and socially isolated across the Archdiocese of Dublin.

In today's more prosperous Ireland, *Crosscare* is still called every day of the year to help thousands of vulnerable people through providing food and shelter, and assisting young people,

individuals and families who are homeless.

This past year has seen pressure on all of *Crosscare's* services where decreasing financial support from statutory bodies is being met with significant increase in demand for services. *Crosscare* responds to the dreadful increase in the numbers of families and children who are now homeless by providing additional family meals to those who are living in hotels along with increasing the provision of food support locally through community based food banks.

Inspired by the example and teaching of Jesus Christ, and conscious of the fact that every person is created in the image and likeness of God, *Crosscare* designs its services to help those in greatest need and to ensure that the services provided are of the highest possible standard.

We have good reason to be proud of *Crosscare* and I would like to thank you, the people of our Archdiocese, for supporting its work each year. Today I appeal to you again to be generous and give what you can to this collection, which takes the place of the Share collection at all Masses today.
