

There is a registration fee of €50 which covers the various costs involved (administration, sacramental programme materials, printing of booklets, music, flowers etc). Catechesis Course

Starting this September the Office of Mission and Ministry will be offering a **Diocesan Certificate in Catechesis.** This is a modular course over seven Saturdays in St Paul's, Arran Quay.

Part One of the course explores Foundations in Catechesis with four modules:

Module One: The Vocation of the Catechist – Called to Share Faith Module Two: Catechesis and the RCIA

Module Three: Catechesis, Method and Content Module Four: Catechesis, Prayer and Liturgy

Part Two of the course explores Catechesis in Practice with three modules

Module Five: Accompanying Families for Baptism Module Six: Accompanying Families for Holy Communion Module Seven: Accompanying Families for Confirmation


