Brackenstown Pilgrimage to the Holy Land 13-21 September 2019

Information Evening Thursday 14th March 8:00pm St. Cronan's Pastoral Centre A representative from MAP Travel will go through the details of the Pilgrimage There will be a slide presentation of the places we will visit.

During Lent we journey with Jesus through the wilderness to Jerusalem. Would you like to go on a physical journey and visit all these places? Over recent weeks in the gospel we have heard about the wedding in Cana, Jesus in the synagogue in Nazareth, Jesus at the Sea of Galilee and on the Mount of Beatitudes. Over the first few Sundays in Lent we will hear about Jesus returning from River Jordan, being tempted in the wilderness, at the Temple of Jerusalem, and his Transfiguration on Mount Tabor. These are all real places in the Holy Land and it is amazing to visit them. Would you like to stand in the River Jordan or go in a boat across the Sea of Galilee? It's amazing how the gospels come alive when you visit these places and the memories stay vivid for a lifetime.
