

The Bible Timeline - Understand the Entire Bible

Reading the Bible should bring us closer to Christ, but understanding it is often difficult. The good news is that you can understand the Bible, and The Bible Timeline, a twenty-four part Bible study, makes it easy.

Presenter Jeff Cavins shows you how fourteen of the Bible's narrative books tell the biblical story from beginning to end and gives you the keys to

understanding the story woven throughout Scripture. The Bible Timeline divides the Bible into twelve colourcoded time periods that make it easier to follow its narrative thread. You will learn the major people, places, and events of the Bible and discover how they all come together to reveal the story of our faith. St. Cronan's Parish will offer The Bible Timeline beginning on Monday 20th February at 7.30 to 9.00 pm. Participants will meet every week to view a 50-minute video presentation followed by a group discussion and an opportunity



Training will take place online, via Zoom, on the following dates:




A meeting of the Pastoral Centre Committee will take place on Thursday 26th January at 7pm in the Pastoral Centre
