

SECOND SUNDAY IN LENT 5TH MARCH 2023 YEAR A

Lenten Reflection the Second Sunday of Lent presents the Transfiguration. This year we have Matthew's account. The event is significant in the life of Jesus as it points ahead to his passion and death in Jerusalem and beyond that to his glorification. For Jesus' disciples, Peter, James and John, it is also a unique moment of insight into Jesus' identity as 'Son' and 'Beloved'. We are all too familiar with recent stories of suffering: the effects of the earthquake in Turkey and Syria, the ongoing war in Ukraine, famine in Somalia and other African countries, homelessness and violence in our country. Just as the meaning of Jesus' passion and death on the cross is transfigured by love and forgiveness, so too these recent



tragedies can be transfigured through the compassion and solidarity we show towards those who are suffering. The response last weekend to the special collection for the survivors of the earthquake in Syria and Turkey shows that such compassion is alive and well.

We may be saying farewell to our current pastoral centre caretaker, Aaron, in the coming weeks as the CE scheme on which he is a participant and which normally runs for two years, is due to draw to a close in mid March. We would be sorry to lose, Aaron, but are hopeful that he may be able to extend his time with us until such time as a replacement on the scheme may be found. It is in this context that Donabate & District CE Project is currently advertising for the position of Caretaker of Brackenstown Parish Pastoral Centre. The position is for 19.5 hours per week, five days weekly. The position is based mainly at the Pastoral Centre adjacent to the parish church but includes other locations, such as St. Joseph's room and the church itself. The Community Employment (CE) programme is designed to help people to get back to work by offering part-time and temporary placements in jobs based within local communities.
