Meet at your parish Church at 11:30am to walk to Colaiste Choilm for Mass at 12:30pm. If you need to drive, you must get a parking permit from your parish office the week before.

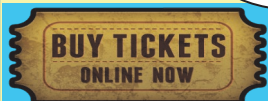
