Is currently enrolling for Junior Infants for September 2020. Application forms are available from the school office and for download from our website www.stcronansjns.ie. Closing date for receipt of completed applications is 10th January 2019.

The ideal is to include both names, Michael and Mary Murphy, to be sure of inclusion in the tax reclaim. Also allowable would be the Murphy Family or Mary Murphy. Single or widowed contributors are not affected as their Dues offering will be in their own name anyhow.
