

Many thanks to all who have left back their Trócaire Boxes. If you have a Box to be returned, you can leave it into the Sacristy or the Parish Office.


Fertility Awareness Course 2016

The Natural Family Planning Teacher Association of Ireland NFPTAI will run a course in Fertility Awareness leading to a certificate to teach Natural Family Planning (symptothermal double check method). The course consists of 6 weekends of lectures followed by a period of practical instruction and research. Lectures will take place 1 weekend per month from September 2016 to February 2017 at St Cronan's Pastoral Centre, Brackenstown with the final exam in June 2017. The course is approved by the Irish College of General Practitioners, An Bord Altranais and the European Institute of Family and Life Education.

A word of Appreciation and Thanks


