On Tuesday we celebrate the first day of spring and Saint Brigid's day! Saint Brigid of Kildare was one of the most important female saints in Ireland. She was a nun, abbess and foundress of many monasteries. The 1st of February was initially a pagan festival called Imbolc, which marked the beginning of Spring. Traditionally St. Brigid's crosses are made out of reeds to remember this



Thursday is the Feast of St. Blaise. It is the tradition on this day to have your throat blessed. As we are still in a time of care about infection there will be a general blessing of throats at the 10:00am Mass.




