It is perhaps timely that the movie Oppenheimer is showing in cinemas this week, since this

Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> August marks the anniversary of the dropping of the first atomic bomb on the Japanese city of Hiroshima in 1945. The narrative of the movie follows the collaborative work of a group of international scientists under the direction of the US government, at a secret location in the New Mexican desert, and in a race against time, to create an atomic bomb. Only in the second half of the movie are the ethical issues surrounding such work addressed, but even as the film's special effects convey something of the extraordinary destructive power of atomic energy, the audience never really gets a sense of what it must have been like for the thousands of Japanese civilians who either were killed immediately or suffered horrific injuries as a result of the detonation of the bombs over Hiroshima and later Nagasaki. The feast of the Transfiguration testifies to a very different power: the power

of self-sacrificing love, compassion for those who are suffering, and forgiveness to completely transform human relationships and overcome evil. It is the power revealed by
