SUMMER MASS SCHEDULE

As you are aware, Fr. Joseph concludes his ministry in Brackenstown on 9th July 2017. His Congregation wish to continue the links with Brackenstown and they have nominated a member of the community to come and serve here for two years. At present this rests with Archbishop Martin and it is only when he formally makes the appointment that he can apply for a visa etc.

Given the time that it takes to process each of these steps, there is a likelihood that we will have a reduced schedule over the summer months to allow for annual retreat and holiday time.

I have contacted the Capuchin Friars in Raheny and they are willing to cover some of the weekend Masses in the times in August and September that I will be away. The Priests in Swords and Rivervalley can cover some but not all the weekdays.

We have been very fortunate that we have not had to reduce our schedule up to now, whereas the other two Parishes have lost a number of Masses. But given that I do not know when the Priest from Fr. Joseph's community will be arriving I have put the following to the Parish Pastoral Council as a way of maintaining as much as possible and of ensuring that there is daily prayer in the Church.

This is the maximum change that I am proposing and if circumstances change then we can revisit it on a month by month basis.

For July, August and September (with the exception of First Fridays) there will be a Service of the Word led by a trained team of Parishioners at 10:00am on Friday mornings, this will lead into the Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament until 6:00pm.

For the month of August there will be no 6:30pm Mass on a Saturday evening. There is 6:30pm Mass available on Saturdays in both Swords and Rivervalley. The 6:30pm Mass will resume on Saturday 2nd of September.

For the month of September there will be no 5:30pm Mass on Sunday evening from the 3rd of September. There is a 6:30pm Mass available in Swords on Sunday Evening. The 5:30pm Mass will resume on Sunday 8th October.

Feast of the Assumption 15th August. There will be no vigil Mass for the Feastday as there is a Vigil Mass at 7:30pm in Swords and Rivervalley. There will be Mass at 10:00am and 7:30pm.

The dates for Baptisms in August have also changed and the new dates are available on the Parish Website

It is with regret that these changes come into effect and in making them we have tried to minimize the impact of lack of services available here by making choices where there are alternatives in Swords or Rivervalley. As we come closer to the changes coming into effect we will let you know the exact details.
