This weekend we move into the Second week of our Advent journey. Like many people, I love the season of Advent: the beautiful readings from Isaiah, the colour in the church, the Advent wreath and candles, the Jesse tree, each in their own way contributing to the biblical narrative of the journey from darkness into light. The invitation to a place of quiet recollection and growing but gentle anticipation runs totally contrary to the frenetic activity of preparations for Christmas.



Advent encourages us, urges us even, to create space for quiet contemplation of the mystery of a God who is continually seeking to come into our lives, to bring peace, hope and joy in the midst of our busyness. Pope Francis writes that *'we are not built for rushing madly about all the time...meditating is like stopping to breathe'*. And he adds: *'The capacity to live and carry forth the love of God, to share his mercy and tenderness with others, is born from contemplation, from a solid friendship with the Lord.'* Next Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> December we are inviting all those exercising ministry in our parish to a morning of reflection and nourishment for ourselves from 10.00am -1.00pm with Rosemary Lavelle at the Carmelite Convent, Seapark, Malahide. Don't let the opportunity pass. We owe it to ourselves and those to whom we minister!

Our **Christmas card, timetable of services and Christmas Offering** envelope are available for collection on tables at the entrances to the church. We would appreciate your assistance in delivering the cards to parishioners (especially neighbours) who may be housebound but who would like to receive them, so that they can follow our Advent and Christmas services on the webcam.

The annual **diocesan collection for the Dublin Council of the Society of St Vincent de Paul** will take place **this weekend 7th & 8th December** and replaces the Share collection. A representative of our local conference of St. Vincent de Paul will speak at all Masses.

A preparation Mass for children and their families preparing for **First Communion** will take place this weekend, **Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> December at 6.00pm and Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> December at 5.00pm.**

**DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION SURVEY:** As you aware, the Department of Education is conducting a survey of parents of children currently in primary school or who will enter primary school in the coming years in relation to school patronage. It is not an abstract or general survey but is about your local school. In other words, parents of children who attend St. Cronan's Junior National School or Scóil Chrónáin Senior National School, are being asked to consider whether they wish those schools to continue under Catholic patronage, where Catholic education is taught as part of the school curriculum, and where part of the preparation for sacraments of First Communion and Confirmation takes place in collaboration with the parish, or whether they wish for a change of patronage. It should be noted that there is already in the Swords area provision for primary schools which are not under religious patronage. While it is important that those who wish for a change in patronage would have their voice heard, it is equally important that those who wish for a Catholic education for their children, and support for sacramental preparation in their school, would have their voice heard also.

The key question you will be asked in the survey is whether you wish for your school to be 'denominational or multi-denominational'. Those who wish for their school to continue to be a Catholic school need to tick 'denominational'. For all the above reasons and to ensure that an accurate picture emerges, **you are strongly urged to participate in this survey if you are a parent or a prospective parent of a Primary school student. Please don't leave it to someone else to decide what kind of school your child will attend. 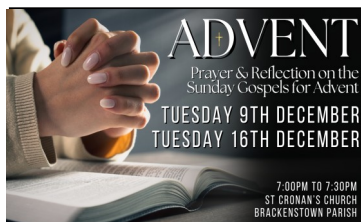

**Donations to the Tap to Donate device can now be included in the CHY tax refund scheme:** When you 'Tap' you now get the opportunity to put in your name, telephone number or email address. This in turn allows the parish to accumulate all donations from the tap device, and from family offering/share/common fund or dues collections. Therefore, for all combined donations over €250.00 the parish can claim the tax back. Your information is only required once; all of your data is handled in strict compliance with data protection laws.

The Tap to Donate device is located to the left of the main doors as you enter the church. Donations to this device go towards the Mass collections. They are split between the Common Fund (1st collection) which supports the priests in the Archdiocese and Share (2nd collection) which provides essential pastoral services for all parishes and particular supports for disadvantaged parishes.

Any tax reclaimed from Revenue goes directly to St. Cronan's parish and is a very important source of income. You can also donate directly to our parish online.
