

Pope Francis has declared this Sunday "The Sunday of the Word of God for Catholics", just after the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity. The day of this new announcement was the feast of Saint Jerome, who translated the Bible into Latin, and who famously said: "Not to know the Scriptures is not to know Christ".

"I love my old Bible, which has accompanied me half my life. It has been with me in my times of joy and times of tears. It is my most precious treasure," said Pope Francis. "I live out of it, and I wouldn't give anything in the world for it." (Pope Francis to young people).

"The Bible is not meant to be placed on a shelf, but to be in your hands, to read often – every day, both on your own and together with others." (Pope Francis)
