A Thought for Corpus Christi

Today we celebrate the gift of the Eucharist given to us in the Last Supper. This Feast was developed to keep the focus of Holy Week on the celebration of Christ's Resurrection and the fact that it would not be in keeping with the sense of that week to celebrate with joy the gift of holy Communion. As we reflect on what it means to be people of the Eucharist, we think of the different stages of the Last Supper: Taking, Blessing, Breaking and Sharing. This is my body given for you. We receive Christ that we may be other Christ's in the world.

St. John Chrysostom wrote "Do you really wish to pay homage to Christ's Body? Then do not neglect him when he is naked. At the same time that you honour him here with hangings made of silk, do not ignore him outside when he perishes from cold and nakedness. For the one who said, 'This is my body' also said 'When I was hungry, you gave me nothing to eat.'

They are looking for volunteers to help manage the Food Bank and help prepare the hampers for the SVP when they call on a Wednesday morning.


