

# FAITH SHARING IN THE AFTERNOONS

"It is God's intention to give himself entirely to us. To get some understanding of what this means, think of a fire into which you put some wood. The fire wants to draw the wood into itself, but finds the wood unlike itself. A process begins that takes time. First the fire makes the wood warm, then it makes it hot, then the wood smokes and crackles on account of the action of the fire: then the hotter the wood gets, the more still and quiet it becomes; and the more peaceful it becomes the more like the fire it is, until it becomes all fire."(Meister Ekhart, O.P.)

Our journey with Jesus and his Spirit, Ekhart tells us, is like the process the fire works on the wood. I invite you to join a group of twenty parishioners who will trace some of the opportunities and challenges of our journey into maturing faith, in a series of five meetings, at twelve noon each day of the retreat. We will explore this journey by using five enduring images that Christians have cherished over the ages to help us all shape our awareness of our Christian vocation. These five images are: Child, Disciple, Steward, Prophet and Lover. Taken alone each one represents a central Christian conviction. Taken together they suggest the shape of our Christian journey into "becoming the fire".
