We have just entered the season of Lent. In keeping with the approach of Spring and the rebirth in nature, it is an opportunity for renewal and new growth for ourselves, particularly in our relationships with God, with self and with others. To assist us in our Lenten journey, the diocesan office for Mission and Ministry have put together an excellent resource, Just Lent. The resource explores a different theme each week related to justice. The theme for this first week of Lent, beginning this Sunday is based around water: Flood and Desert. It ties in with our Sunday readings and also with the theme of this year's Trócaire campaign, which focuses on the people of Malawi and their daily struggle to access clean water. The great thing about each of the weekly themes that Just Lent proposes is that there is something practical, however small, we can do about it.

Thanks as well to all those who use the white envelopes for the first and second collections. These envelopes allow the parish to include your contributions for the annual CHY tax reclaim. 
