

College last Thursday having completed the Pathways Programme. The programme takes place one evening a week over two years and is an opportunity to learn, reflect and discuss many different areas of faith. Speaking on behalf of the class, Louise highlights what the course meant to them:

"Pathways has set me on the road of discovering my faith in ways I never knew existed - enriching and deepening my belief in Jesus Christ along the way. When a person becomes renewed in Christ, you find you don't talk the same, think the same or do things in the same way. One's whole being has been converted to God and so one has to continually learn who one is, as baptised in Christ Jesus. Pathways helps us on this journey."
