The highlight of our year so far was the performance in our church on Wednesday night of *I am Mark*, Stefan Smart's presentation of the Gospel of Mark. It was a powerful presentation of the earliest and shortest of the four canonical Gospels, bringing to life both the person of Jesus Christ and the sense of urgency that Mark brings to his writing, the urgency to proclaim the Good News.

It was clear, both in Stefan's performance and in his response to the comments and questions that came from the floor afterwards that Stefan shares Mark's passion to share the Good News as often and

as widely as possible. That is how he experiences God's call in his life today.




