

LAY MINISTRY COLLECTION - MAY 14 AND 15





Over the next two weekends we will focus on praying for and supporting Christian vocations. All of us receive our vocation at Baptism and throughout our lives Jesus calls us to use what we have received in building up the Church. In the ceremony of Baptism this is seen in the Ephphata where the ears and mouth of the one



being Baptised are opened to hear and know the voice of the Lord and to live the Christian vocation in our words. attitudes and actions. When Jesus speaks his word, it is all the baptised who not only hear it but are called to share it. This is at the heart of the recovery of listening in the Synodal Process and is the foundation of the Building Hope Strategy.

Next weekend we will reflect, pray and support the work of Lay Ministry in our Diocese. This week I invite you to reflect, pray and support the ministry of Priests in our Diocese and around the world.

This year we had one ordination of Fr. Joe Keegan in Clondalkin and at present there are no students for the Priesthood in the Dublin Diocese. While the vocations office is supporting the enquiries they receive, they need our prayers and encouragement for those discerning a call to priesthood.

One of the ways that we have had in this Parishes of supporting those in formation is through the St. Joseph's Young Priests Society. Unfortunately our group is close to being closed due to lack of membership. I am appealing to you to consider joining them to pray, learn about the work of the Society and give a little financial support. They meet once a month in the Pastoral Centre for a hour and commit to saying the St. Joseph's Young Priest Society Prayer. There will be members at the back of the Church with information or you can email the Parish Office.

Promoting and supporting the vocation we receive in Baptism is the sign of a healthy and vibrant Church. On this Good Shepherd V Sunday let us make a commitment to pray that where the Lord is calling, there is a generous response to follow.
