#### **OUR LINKS WITH ST. MEL'S CATHEDRAL**

Many of you will have seen the RTE documentary about the destruction by fire and subsequent restoration of St. Mel's Cathedral, Longford. A special Mass for its rededication was written by Dr. John O'Keeffe, Director of Sacred Music in St. Patrick's College, Maynooth.

A workshop for choirs took place in Longford last Saturday to launch this new "Mass of St. Mel." Our Parish Choir travelled up for the occasion.

At the annual Church Music Summer School in Maynooth in 2011, Dr. O'Keeffe issued a challenge to choir directors. This was to get their congregations singing his newly composed Apostles' Creed, the first completed part of his St. Mel's Mass.

Brackenstown took up the challenge. Dr. O'Keeffe's intention was to make this Mass fully congregational-friendly, as, before he went ahead with the rest of the composition, he wanted to make sure it would work.

We are very proud to say that Dr. O'Keeffe publicly announced that he would never have completed his Mass except for the successful execution of the pilot scheme in Brackenstown. We had sent him a recording of our congregation singing the Creed and sent an account of how we introduced it at our 11.00am Mass on Sundays. Fr. Paul was particularly helpful in encouraging the congregation through the initial stages of learning.

We are also proud to report that we piloted the Gloria as well and we were invited to talk to the assembled choirs about the best way to get the congregation involved.

We look forward to introducing the rest of the Mass parts to our wonderful congregation here in St. Cronan's.

# 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of Easter 19<sup>th</sup> April 2015 SHARE SUNDAY

Dear Friends,

Recent years have seen great changes in the Archdiocese of Dublin. In many ways these have been difficult years, but these difficulties should not cloud the remarkable change for good that is taking place in the Archdiocese.

Parishes and parish groupings have never before been so active. There is a real sense of working together for mission between priest and people, lay and religious. There is a real interest among many in developing a personal adult faith in Jesus Christ as a lifelong process.

The population of the Archdiocese of Dublin is increasing and will continue to increase in the years to come. Our process of change and renewal will have to take on new momentum. If we want the children of the future to be able to experience the joy of the Gospel then we will have to invest in fresh forms of faith education, based in new ways in our parishes.

All this depends on Share and I appeal to your continued generosity.
