

Icon of Our Lady

A question was asked through the Suggestion Box in the Main Porch as to why the Icon of Our Lady was moved to the Pastoral Centre. Six years ago when the Pastoral Centre was being planned the writer of the Icon offered to create this Icon as a prayer for the successful completion and good use of the Pastoral Centre. At an Evening Prayer in March 2012 the Icon was placed in the Church until it could take its intended place at the entrance to the Pastoral Centre.
