The theme of this Jubilee year in the Church which began on Christmas Eve last is 'Pilgrims of Hope'. May this season of Lent help us to deepen our relationship with Christ and our commitment to one another, so that God's kingdom may grow. As Pope Francis' health remains critical, we keep him foremost in our prayers at this time, along with the medical team responsible for his care.



Trócaire Boxes will be available at the back of the Church this weekend

Trocaire is an agency of the Irish Bishops' Conference particularly concerned with justice and development overseas. **Trocaire Lenten campaign packs** (which include the Lenten donation box) will be available on tables around the church from this weekend. This year's campaign, entitled Stronger Together, focuses on communities affected by the effects of climate change in Guatemala and other parts of the world. For example, if you pay income tax and your total annual combined donation (including Family Offering, First and Second collections and Christmas/Easter Offerings) is €250 or more per year, we can claim a refund from Revenue on the tax that you have already paid. This refund is available through the CHY Charitable Donation Scheme for approved charities. Last year the Parish received a CHY income tax refund of €44,960, which was of immense help to the parish finances.
