


Laetare (rejoice) Sunday lets us know that we are midway through our Lenten journey, and with the help of our liturgy group, we are busy planning our liturgies for Holy Week and Easter. Our Easter card and timetable of services for Holy Week and Easter will be available for collection at the entrances to the church from this weekend. As you will see, there will be something on in the church each evening during Holy Week, culminating in the Easter Triduum which begins with the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday evening and runs through to Easter Sunday.

Our **Just Lent** series continues, and this 4th Sunday of Lent, the theme focuses on racial justice. The Gospel reminds us that

Jesus came to save, not just some, but all people, while the second reading tells us that every human being is 'God's work of art'. Pope Francis writes in Fratelli Tutti that 'every brother or sister in need, when abandoned or ignored by the society in which I live, becomes an existential foreigner, even though born in the same country. They may be citizens with full rights, yet they are treated like foreigners in their own country. Racism is a virus that quickly mutates and, instead of disappearing, goes into hiding, and lurks in waiting." Loving God, in this season of Lent, you call us to act justly, love tenderly and walk humbly with each other, so that we can build your kingdom of justice and peace, your kingdom of love and truth, your kingdom of holiness and grace in our world today.
