Read St Luke's Gospel over 5 Weeks


Brackenstown Bible Study Group invite you to join us in reading St Luke's Gospel

Due to the Coronavirus pandemic the study will be home based.

Each Monday a short five minute animated video will be emailed to you, this gives an overview of the reading for that week. We will start on Monday 25th May and the video for that week will cover chapters 1 & 2 of Luke. There will be an optional Zoom, on-line group discussion/questions and answers facility available on each Monday night.

The current difficult situation may be an opportunity for you to deepen your relationship with Christ through becoming more familiar with the Word of God. There is no charge to join in so why not give it a go?

When visiting the Church please:

- ⇒ Use the anti-bacterial hand sanitiser in the porch, there is one at each door.
- ⇒ Only use the open benches and only one person per bench.
- ⇒ Immediately after leaving the bench, wipe where you have touched with the surface cleaner and tissue on the table at the main door.
- ⇒ Avoid having conversations inside the Church.
- ⇒ If you are talking out side make sure you are 2mts (6ft) apart.
- ⇒ At all times inside and outside the Church keep social distancing.
- ⇒ Both external and internal doors at the Main entrance must be left open.
- ⇒ Some windows are also open for ventilation.



Return to public worship, confessions, Baptisms, Weddings, First Communions and Confirmation:

- ◇ The 20th July has been set in the roadmap as the date for public worship to resume, provided all the 'opening up' measures are going as predicted.
- ◇ However this will mean that Social Distancing will remain though it may be brought to 1 metre (3 feet). This means a maximum of 80—120 in the Church. These restrictions may be with us for some time.
- ◇ After 20th July we will open for Baptism Bookings. New dates will be set and there will be only four families per session with a limit in attendance.
- ◇ Weddings are available with 10 people attending, this will be increased after 20th July.
- ◇ First Communion and Confirmation are deferred until September and even then these celebrations will have restrictions.
- ◇ Confessions are under review at this time. One of the main concerns is privacy for the person coming to confession which is why holding them in the Car Park wouldn't work. But we are looking at ways that we can celebrate this Sacrament.

These conditions for the return to public worship depend on the roadmap of re-opening society that the Government have set out. It is great to be able to work towards having the Sacraments celebrated in our Church again and meeting here as God's family. Please continue to pray for all our frontline workers and for our communities that we will work together to overcome COVIS 19 and open up our society safely.
