**effection** As a place of pilgrimage, Lourdes has a place of place in the heart of generations of Irish people. Since the time of St. Bernadette Soubirous, it has attracted pilgrims as a special place of prayer and of physical, spiritual and emotional healing. The Dublin Diocesan pilgrimage to Lourdes takes place each year from 7<sup>th</sup> -12<sup>th</sup> September. For the first time since Covid, the annual Diocesan Pilgrimage will include sick pilgrims who are accommodated at the Accueil Notre Dame close to the Grotto. Fr. Martin Noone, director of the diocesan pilgrimage, describes it as 'a hugely positive experience for the pilgrims as well as providing respite for their families and carers at home'. Last year students from Colaiste Choilm took part for the first time as volunteer helpers. Another group of students will participate this year, providing practical assistance to sick pilarims. Parishioners are welcome to participate in the pilgrimage. Others may not choose to travel but may wish to become Associate Members of the Diocesan Pilgrimage to Lourdes in September. A special outdoor collection will take place after all Masses this weekend to assist in funding the participation of sick pilgrims. Those who support the collection are enrolled as Associate Members of the Pilgrimage. 

#### **Catechesis** Course

Starting this September the Office of Mission and Ministry will be offering a Diocesan Certificate in Catechesis. This is a modular course over seven Saturdays in St Paul's, Arran Quay. Part One of the course explores Foundations in Catechesis with four modules: Module One: The Vocation of the Catechist - Called to Share Faith; Module Two: Catechesis and the RCIA

Module Three: Catechesis, Method and Content; Module Four: Catechesis, Prayer and Liturgy

Part Two of the course explores Catechesis in Practice with three modules

Module Five: Accompanying Families for Baptism; Module Six: Accompanying Families for Holy Communion Module Seven: Accompanying Families for Confirmation. On completion of the course participants will receive the Diocesan Certificate in Catechesis. Assessment will be done through journaling.
