COVID-19 CHANGES

Up to the 22nd of October the following health and safety practices remain in place in St. Cronan's Church:

You have to wear a face mask (u 12's don't have to do this),

Sanitise your hands as you enter the Church

Keep a 2m distance from others when seated in the Church

(2m between individuals or family groups)

Ventilation is very important so the windows will be fully open.

Cleaning of the Church after Mass.

From the 6th September to 22nd October:

Please follow the health and safety measures above.

At 10:00am Mass there will be only 1 steward at the door to make sure people have face masks and sanitise their hands and to keep a count. They will no longer bring you to your seat or guide you out at the end.

#SeasonOfCreation

When choosing a seat please follow the green marker for individuals and yellow markers for couples. Once you choose your seat please use that one even if you get up to light a candle.

For family groups there is a maximum of six in a group per bench.

You can light candles before Mass but the church closes after Mass.

When leaving the church, please let the back benches move out first and then follow bench by bench keeping 2m social distancing until you are outside. Please make sure to move away from the exit when outside so as not to cause an obstruction

For weekend Masses there will be two stewards at the 6:00pm, 9:00am and 5:00pm. Their role is to count and ensure health and safety measures are being followed.

At the 11:00am Mass we will have four stewards given the high numbers that attend that Mass.

Numbers in Church: The maximum number that can be comfortably currently seated in St. Cronan's Church is 260 people. This means that with the increase to 50% we can accommodate 130 people in the Church. This number excludes stewards, musicians and clergy.

From 20th September:

Meeting will be allowed in the Pastoral Centre under certain restrictions. Leaders of the various groups will be advised of this when they book in through the Parish Office.

Singing will be allowed in Church with masks.

We have come this far together and looked after one another, let us keep going and see this through to the end.


