We have journeyed through Advent, lighting the candles on the Advent wreath, expressing the themes of hope, peace and joy respectively, and adding symbols to the Jesse tree, reminding us that our Christian story has its roots in Old Testament expectation, yearning, struggle, yet ultimate trust in a God who is faithful.

On the fourth Sunday of Advent we light the last purple candle, which reminds us that at the heart of the mystery we celebrate at Christmas is love.

God loves us so much that he enters our world in the most humble and vulnerable way imaginable, as a child born to Galilean parents in search of a place to stay.

God puts himself at the mercy of human hospitality, just as he does today. The only response such love asks is that of a child or a shepherd: joy, wonder, and gratitude. Our joy may be tinged this year by the sadness of a loved one being no longer among us or by tragedies unfolding in different parts of the world, not least in the land of Jesus' birth, but let us take time to celebrate this mystery of love with family and loved ones, and may our joy give birth to love and compassion for those who need our presence at this time.
