



**Catholic Schools Week** and **Christian Unity Week** both conclude this Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> January. Catholic Schools Week provides an annual opportunity to acknowledge the work of Catholic schools in our parish and around the country in providing holistic education of our young people informed by the beliefs and values of the Catholic church. It is an opportunity to salute the extraordinary commitment of our school principals, Boards of Management, Parent Associations, teachers, SNAs and auxiliary staff to delivering the highest standards of education to the young people in their care.

The schools also support the work of the parish in preparing children and their parents for the celebrations of the sacraments of First Reconciliation, First Communion and Confirmation. One of the highlights of the Advent season was the wonderful Carol Service which Scoil Chronain SNS presented in the church just before Christmas, a beautiful collaboration of pupils, teachers and members of our parish senior choir. Christian Unity Week, which is also celebrated annually from 18<sup>th</sup>- 25<sup>th</sup> January, reminds us that, as Catholics, we are part of a wider family of those who believe in and try to follow Jesus. There is richness in diversity, and we are grateful for the witness of our fellow Christians in Swords and opportunities to collaborate with them in the service of God's kingdom. The prayers and reflections for this year's Christian Unity Week are prepared by the Armenian Apostolic Church, in collaboration with the Armenian Catholic and Evangelical Churches. Established in the early 4<sup>th</sup> century the Armenian Church is one of the oldest churches, tracing its roots back to the apostolic era, when Thaddeus and Bartholomew evangelised in Armenia.

The following prayer is offered during the week: **'Jesus Christ, you have brought us together in all our diversity as your family and church. In the face of so many situations on earth, where hope has given way to despair and wounded hearts, renew our hope in the Holy Spirit's work of changing the world. Move us to spread this hope to everyone everywhere. You are the true Light, who casts out the darkness of sin and shines into our hearts the joy and hope of your eternal love.'**


