## PARTNERSHIP OF BRACKENSTOWN, SWORDS, RIVER VALLEY & DONABATE PARISHES **3RD SUNDAY OF LENT** 23RD MARCH 2025 YEAR C

Earlier this week, representatives from our parish attended a pastoral area meeting in Blanchardstown as part of the Synodal pathway. Since the Synod of the universal Church concluded in Rome in October, we are able to turn our attention to the national synod of the Irish church, which is due to take place next year. The process began in 2021 when the Irish bishops announced a five year process leading up to a general assembly in October 2026. Parishioners probably remember that consultation meetings were held at parish level in 2022 at which they were invited to list what were there many hopes and concerns for the future of the Church in Ireland. The fruits of these meetings were gathered into a diocesan document which in turn was integrated into a national document, which became the Irish contribution to the universal Synod in Rome. The Irish document, Synthesis of the Consultation in Ireland for the Diocesan Stage of the Universal Synod 2012-2023 can be downloaded at: Synod National Synthesis Document. Key themes which were highlighted in the Irish document include: baptism - belonging - co-responsibility - lay ministry- abuse – youth –women –sexuality and LGBT+ issues and faith formation. The purpose

of this week's meeting, which brought together clergy, chairs of parish pastoral councils, parish synodal animators and parish pastoral workers from across three deaneries, was to reflect on those themes and try to identify priorities which should go forward to the national Synod next year. Similar gatherings will take place in the four other pastoral areas across the diocese in the coming weeks. These will all feed into a national pre-Synodal assembly in October this year in preparation for next year's Synod.

This week the final discernment for the nine members of the Diocesan Pastoral Council from across the Diocese takes place. 23 women and men nominated by the Deanery members have reached this final level of discernment, which will follow the process which has guided each stage of this journey: namely the synodal way of prayer, silence, discussion, prayer and decision.
