The theme which the Just Lent campaign proposes for our consideration during the second week of Lent is homelessness. The Gospel for the Second Sunday of Lent, sees Simon Peter suggesting that three tents are set up on the Mount of transfiguration. Tents in the Bible are symbolic of God's permanent presence among us, but today our towns and cities have people sheltering in tents because they are homeless. The reasons why some people are homeless are complex. Nevertheless on a cold winter's night, it is heartbreaking to think of people sleeping rough with only a piece of canvas for a roof. The situation is not helped by others setting fire to a premises which is earmarked to accommodate refugees. Meanwhile in Gaza we are aware of over a million displaced people packed into the city of Rafa sleeping in tents, with absolutely no facilities, and now threatened with having to move again. As followers of Jesus we are challenged to find practical ways to express our compassion for those who are in need.

This coming Wednesday, we are delighted to host I am Mark, a dramatic presentation of Mark's Gospel, performed by Stefan Smart. This is a

A preparation Mass for Confirmation will take place next weekend at 6.00pm on Saturday 2nd March and 5.00pm on Sunday 3rd March.


## 2024 ENVELOPE BOXES
