

It was at Nevers, in the Mother House of the Sisters of Charity, the Convent of St Gildard that St Bernadette Soubirous took the veil for 13years and lived a simple life dedicated to God and

others. Her incorrupt body rests in the chapel in a glass reliquary. She died in 1879, later beatified and canonised in 1933.

#### THE ROSARY - MAKE A NEW BEGINNING!




