Following the Government Announcement on Thursday outlined below is the plan for the next few weeks. As our numbers are more limited than our last reopening we cannot accommodate as many people. Please follow the advice of the stewards and support them in their work by your kindness and cooperation. We need more stewards and cleaners so if you can help, please email the Parish Office.

New Mass Schedule: From 10th May 50 people will be allowed to attend worship.

Weekday Masses will be at 10:00am (Monday to Saturday)

The weekend Masses will change to the following: (from 15th May)

Saturday Vigil will be at 6:00pm

Sunday Morning will be at 9:00am and 11:00am

Sunday Evening will be at 5.00pm

Baptisms: (under the present restrictions only two households can mix indoors)

The implications this has for Baptisms is that we will offer individual Baptisms at which only the parents and two godparents can attend. As things open up we can allow more but from the 10th May any family who wish to have Baptism like this will be able to book in through the Parish website.

First Holy Communion and Confirmation are on hold for the time being.

Weddings: 46 guests may come to the ceremony, however there are restrictions of less numbers at receptions.

Funerals: 50 people are allowed attend

In the initial stage of reopening the pod system ie: the church split into two sections, will not be in operation as there is a maximum of 50 for worship only.

The Pastoral Centre remains closed for meetings and all Parish Groups / Meeting will continue by Zoom.
