

Revised Procedures for the Sunday Mass Collections come into effect this weekend. The (red and blue) collection pouches will be placed on the hooks at the end of each pew on either side of the centre aisle **only**. Parishioners seated on either side of the centre aisle are asked to pass first the red and then the blue pouches sideways along each pew, across the two intermediate aisles and towards the wall on either side of the church. The pouches are then placed in the large wicker baskets at each Confession box. The baskets containing the pouches should be brought into the sacristy at the conclusion of Mass. We appreciate the cooperation of parishioners and visitors with these procedures.
