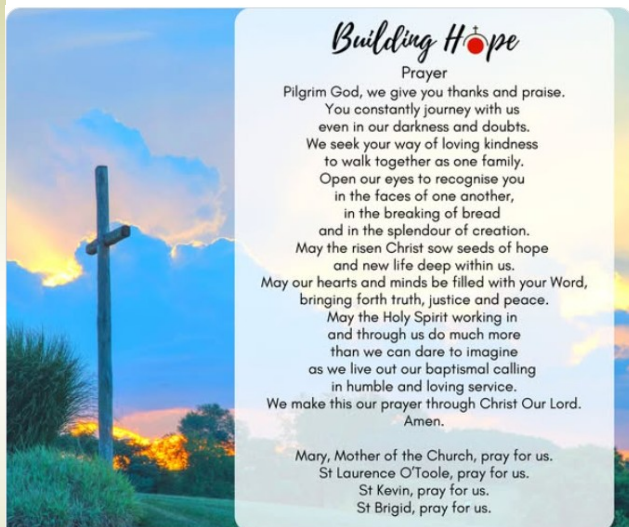

This weekend, members of the Parish Pastoral Council will present the fourth and final pillar of the **Building Hope** diocesan programme for pastoral development, **Social Justice**. A brief summary of the feedback from the questionnaires on the three previous pillars: Welcome and Inclusion, Faith, and Servant Leadership, is presented on the blue display board at the back of the church, which parishioners are invited to consult as a reminder of the journey of consultation we have engaged in over the past four months, together with parishioners from our partnership parishes (Swords & Drynam, River Valley and Donabate).

Our next step is for the Partnership Pastoral Council to reflect together on the feedback from the consultation and draw up a plan, indicating which recommendations can be addressed at partnership level and which pertain to the needs of a particular parish. We were delighted to get so many suggestions from parishioners. We clearly cannot address them all, so we will endeavour to address those which parishioners saw as priorities, classifying them as immediate, medium or long term goals.

The work of addressing our pastoral needs and priorities is also not simply the task of the Parish Pastoral Council or of the clergy; it is the call of each of us as baptised members of this community of faith. With the guidance of the Holy Spirit, may we together ensure a future of faith and of Christian life and service in our community.

This **Saturday 1st November**, the universal Church celebrates the **Feast of All Saints** with Mass at 10.00am. As Christians we draw inspiration, hope and encouragement from those who from the earliest centuries have witnessed to their faith in Christ Jesus by their words, lives, and sometimes sufferings. The feast also reminds us that it is the calling of every baptised person to be a saint. On Sunday 2nd November we celebrate the **Commemoration of All Souls**. It is a long standing tradition in the Catholic Church to pray for those who have died. As we recite in the Apostles Creed, we believe in that great communion in Christ of those who are living and those who have gone before us in faith and which we refer to as the Communion of Saints. We remember them with love, thanksgiving and hope, and we trust that they are interceding for us. Later this month we will celebrate our annual Mass, remembering those parishioners who have died in the past year. It is a wonderful opportunity to reach out again to their grieving families and to assure them that we continue to remember their loved one before God. The Mass offers all of us an opportunity to remember our own deceased family members and friends and to draw strength from gathering together around the table of the Risen Lord.
