Reflection

A key focus of the diocesan Building Hope initiative is to equip and empower parishioners to take on more leadership roles in parish life and ministry: gathering and leading parishioners in prayer in the absence of an ordained minister, offering opportunities for faith development, or leading a Communion service for residents in some of our nursing homes, as well as serving as members of baptism or funeral ministry teams. None of this can happen without training. To this end a diocesan team are currently delivering an excellent five session course on Servant Leadership. Led by Peter Siney, a parishioner and former Parish Pastoral Worker here, and Patricia Carroll, director of the diocesan office of Mission and Ministry the course is open to everyone but may be of particular interest to members of Parish Pastoral Councils and those in a parish ministry. This week they led an excellent session on the skill of listening and on taking a leadership role in a parish group. Even if you have missed the first two sessions, it is not too late to come to the remaining three sessions which continue on 11th, 18th and 25th May from 7.30pm-9pm.
