DIGITAL SCHOOLS of distinction

St. Cronan's Junior National School

On Tuesday November 25th, the Minister for Education and Skills, Jan O'Sullivan TD, presented St. Cronan's Junior National School with a Digital Schools of Distinction Award. St. Cronan's J.N.S. is one of Three Junior Schools in Ireland to have received this prestigious award. Their success in ICT can be attributed to the whole school community, from management to staff, pupils and parents.

Since 2003, they have successfully integrated ICT in the curriculum and created an ICT culture by introducing a computer room, interactive whiteboards, visualisers, a digital library, databiz, text a parent, digital blue cameras, school servers, software and lessons on cyberbullying, powerpoint and scratch computer programming.

Their website was recognised as the 'Best School Website' in Ireland in 2013 (Eircom Junior Spider Award) and they recently won 'Best Junior School Film' in the FÍS Film Festival.

St. Cronan's Senior National School

The Digital Schools of Distinction programme for primary schools is awarded by demonstrating excellence in the school's approach to the integration of ICT in learning and teaching.

For the Digital Schools of Distinction Award St. Cronans Senior School demonstrated how the children use ICT to create stories, graphs, presentations, animations, short films, software programs and our school website.

In St. Cronan's Senior School each classroom is equipped with a laptop, interactive whiteboard, visualiser and classroom computer. The teachers in St. Cronan's SNS have fully integrated ICT into administration, planning and teaching.

We are delighted to be the first school in Ireland along with St. Cronan's Junior School to be the first school in Ireland on the same campus to be awarded the Digitial School of Distinction Award.
