

When I asked children in our primary school this week why Lent was forty days duration, they told me that it was because Jesus spent forty days in the desert. They are on the money. In this Sunday's Gospel, we hear of Jesus being led into the desert immediately following his baptism. It is a place where he can encounter God free from distractions, except the distraction of temptations, and it proves a turning point in his life and the beginning of his mission. Lent for us, too, is an invitation to find or create a desert space, where we can encounter God more deeply and make a new beginning in our lives. Our resolve to give up something or take on something new is primarily about

freeing ourselves from the distractions that occupy so much of our

time, energy and focus, so that God can reach us. They are also about entering into deeper solidarity with those who are suffering and those who do not even have the choice as to whether or not they will fast. May our efforts to restrain our more superficial desires during Lent lead us to the new life of resurrection which we celebrate at Easter!

Archbishop Farrell has given approval for a DIOCESAN COLLECTION to be taken up in support of the people of TURKEY AND SYRIA affected by the devastating earthquakes on Monday 5th February. We may be saying farewell to our current pastoral centre caretaker, Aaron, in the coming weeks as the CE scheme on which he is a participant and which normally runs for two years, is due to draw to a close in mid March. We would be sorry to lose, Aaron, but are hopeful that he may be able to extend his time with us until such time as a replacement on the scheme may be found. It is in this context that Donabate & Donabate & District CE Project is currently advertising for the position of Caretaker of Brackenstown Parish Pastoral Centre. The position is for 19.5 hours per week, five days weekly. The position is based mainly at the Pastoral Centre adjacent to the parish church but includes other locations, such as St. Joseph's room and the church itself. The Community Employment (CE) programme is designed to help people to get back to work by offering part-time and temporary placements in jobs based within local communities. Trocaire Lenten campaign packs (including a Trocaire box) are available at the church entrances from this weekend. This year's campaign focuses on Somalia, where lack of rain over a number of years has led to a failure of harvests and a devastating food shortage. A representative from Trocaire will speak at all Masses about the campaign on Sat/Sun. 4/5th March, Second Sunday of Lent.

On behalf of Irish Water, GMC are carrying out work on a new



trunk watermain to improve security and resilience of water supply for 350,000 people in North Dublin across homes, hospitals and businesses.

To facilitate these works, a water outage is required from 1am Sunday night to 11am Sunday morning - 26th February.

The Diocesan Office for Mission and Ministry are putting on a **Lenten programme** called Building Hope Through Servant Leadership, aimed particularly at Pastoral Council members and those in pastoral ministries. It will run from 7.00pm on

five Monday evenings in Lent at St. Paul's Arran Quay.
